

Heidi K. Gardner, PhD, is the author of the best-selling book Smart Collaboration and newly released Smarter Collaboration: A New Approach to Breaking Down Barriers and Transforming Work (both Harvard Business Press). A Distinguished Fellow at Harvard Law School and previously a professor at Harvard Business School, she is currently the faculty chair and instructor in multiple executive education programs at both institutions.

Named by Thinkers 50 as a Next Generation Business Guru, Dr. Gardner is a sought-after advisor, keynote speaker, and facilitator for organizations across a wide range of industries globally. With her team at Gardner & Co, she works extensively with boards, executive teams, and other senior leaders to boost performance by embedding the principles and practices of smarter, agile, cross-silo collaboration within those groups and across the broader organization and ecosystem. Her work results in concrete, quantifiable performance improvements.

Altogether, Dr. Gardner has authored (or co-authored) more than 80 books, chapters, case studies, and articles.
